In 2004, the Davison Community Fund was established to serve the communities of Davison, Davison Township, and Richfield Township. Founders Tim Elkins, Pete Auger, and Robert Callis wanted to create an avenue for giving in Davison. Since that time, the Fund has grown from \$500 in annual grantmaking to \$9,500 in annual funding to support the community. In total, the Davison Community Fund has provided \$64,920 in grants to support area charitable projects.
